NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME-NSS

The National Service Scheme (NSS) at Agrawan Heritage University, Agra, is established under the aegis of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India. Guided by the NSS motto — “Not Me But You”, the scheme aims to instill the spirit of voluntary community service, leadership, and social responsibility among students.

Through various community-oriented programs, the NSS Cell at AHU encourages students to extend their classroom learning beyond the university boundaries, enabling them to develop empathy, discipline, and civic sense while contributing to nation-building.

Objectives of NSS at AHU

1. To understand the community in which the students work and identify social issues.
2. To develop a sense of social and civic responsibility.
3. To apply classroom knowledge for practical benefit of society.
4. To promote national integration, cultural harmony, and environmental protection.
5. To encourage leadership qualities, discipline, and teamwork.
6. To engage students in programs related to health, education, sanitation, and heritage preservation.

University NSS Coordinator	Dr. Satendra Singh Chauhan	Overall supervision of NSS activities across the university; planning annual NSS calendar; coordination with State NSS Cell and university departments; submission of reports to the Registrar and Vice-Chancellor.
Programme Officer	Mr. Mohit Yadav	Implementation of NSS programs at the unit level; guidance to volunteers; maintaining activity records; conducting regular meetings and field visits.
Student Leaders (NSS Volunteers)	Appointed annually	Assisting in organizing activities, motivating peers, maintaining attendance, and leading community projects.

NSS Cell Structure at AHU

- NSS Cell Headquarters: Administrative Block, Agrawan Heritage University, Agra.
- Faculty Advisors: One NSS Programme Officer from each department.
- Volunteer Units: Each unit comprises 50–100 student volunteers.
- Coordination Office: Managed under the supervision of Dr. Satendra Singh Chauhan, supported by Mr. Mohit Yadav and student representatives.

Major Activities Conducted by NSS Cell

1. Regular Activities

- Cleanliness and plantation drives under *Swachh Bharat Abhiyan*.

- Blood donation camps and health check-ups in collaboration with local hospitals.
- Awareness campaigns on women empowerment, traffic safety, and digital literacy.
- Heritage walk programs and cultural preservation drives in Agra region.
- Celebration of important national and international days (Yoga Day, NSS Day, Republic Day, etc.).

2. Special Camps

- Seven-day annual residential camps in nearby villages focusing on sanitation, education, digital literacy, and environmental protection.
- Community awareness programs on government initiatives like Mission Shakti, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao, and Jal Jeevan Mission.

3. Extension & Outreach

- Collaborations with NGOs, Gram Panchayats, and government departments for social welfare activities.
- Participation in state and national-level NSS workshops, youth camps, and leadership programs.

Achievements

- Successful organization of university-level *Swachhata Abhiyan* and plantation drives across campus.
- Active volunteer participation in *Mission Shakti Phase V* program under Agriculture Department.
- Contribution to blood donation and health awareness campaigns in collaboration with Geeta Medical Store, Rohta.
- Recognition from local authorities for exemplary service during community health programs.

Future Goals

1. To expand NSS units to every department of the university.
2. To adopt a nearby village for year-round development activities.
3. To introduce *Digital Volunteer Training* and *Heritage Awareness Programs* for students.
4. To collaborate with state and central government agencies for youth development initiatives.
5. To encourage at least one community project per student per semester.
